
EAA Chapter 1246 Annual Fish Fry - April 23, 2011

Smoke, Electric Power Loss Complicate United A320 Landing

A United Airlines Airbus A320 made an emergency landing in New Orleans (KMSY) just minutes after departing the airport Wednesday. The pilots noticed smoke in the flight deck as the aircraft climbed through 4,000 feet. An electrical failure soon followed and all avionics displays went blank.
