#### Homebuilt Aircraft Final Inspection - What a DAR is looking for

Is your Experimental Aircraft almost ready for it's final inspection? Are you ready? Join us for our Monthly EAA Chapter meeting where our own Mel Asberry, an award winning DAR, goes through the inspection process and details what's involved in getting that approval slip.

Mel is the 2005 recipient of EAA's Tony Bingelis Award. He has volunteered as an EAA Technical Counselor since 1986, advising aircraft builders on safe completion of their projects. He became an EAA Flight Advisor in 1994, helping local pilots assess their flying skills to be able to safely fly their newly built or restored aircraft. Mr. Asberry has also written several articles for the benefit of the aviation community.

He has written nine programs and 37 technical articles for his chapter newsletter. He has also written two chapter programs for other chapters. He has also presented a number of forums at the Southwest EAA Regional Fly-In, an event co-founded by Tony Bingelis.

Mel continues to educate and guide aircraft builders through numerous presentations in Texas, as well as forums during EAA AirVenture Oshkosh.

He has constructed two ultralights and one motorglider, as well as an RV-6 aircraft that has won numerous awards. In 1993 he won the Southwest Regional Fly-In Kit Built Custom Workmanship Award, while in 1994 he won the Best All-Metal Homebuilt Airplane award at the Sun 'n Fun Fly-In at Lakeland, Florida, as well as the Grand Champion Kit-Built award at the All-American Sport Aviation Fly-In. In 1995, he won Homebuilt Outstanding Aircraft at Sun 'n Fun.

#### Rock 'n roll: Take a ride upside down



Rolling inverted, diving, pulling 4 Gs in a split second, the split-S sends adrenaline flowing and blood pumping as full left aileron and rudder deflection rolls the 1975 Citabria upside down, momentary forward pressure stabilizes it, and back pressure forces the occupants of the tandem taildragger against their seats while plunging toward the earth. Watching aircraft dance across the sky at airshows in ways one wouldn't think possible can give the impression that aerobatics are complicated. However, an aerobatic workout of loops, hammerheads, rolls, Immelmans, Cuban eights, snap rolls, spins, and the split-S demonstrates that many of the maneuvers are built from the basic loop and roll—and can be mastered with practice, just like any other skill in aviation. Still, for beginners, sights of the ground, horizon, and sky flash by seemingly as quickly as tumbling in an orbitron ride. Read more and watch AOPA Live

#### Sleet first, now snow?





"The snowfall began in most areas around midnight, moving from south to north through the region. Totals varied widely, but were generally greater to the east. At Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport, the official snowfall by sunrise was 1.8 inches. But people near Love Field reported receiving more than 4 inches; in Richardson, 5 inches; and in Kaufman, nearly 8 inches."

#### Ebay Sale: Shell Of Harrier Jump Jet

Rescued from a scrapyard in 1997, the restored two-seat fist generation ex-RAF 4 SQN Harrier Jump Jet currently available on ebay.co.uk was accepting bids over \$112,000, when last we checked, but if you want an engine you'll be paying more. It's current owner, 33-year-old former RAF mechanic, Chris Wilson, says the decommissioned display-worthy aircraft could be made airworthy with the addition of the appropriate Rolls Royce engine, sold separately (and not by him). That fantasy will take some work. The aircraft's front cockpit is "around 80-percent complete" (it does include a Martin Baker mk9 ejection seat), and the rear cockpit is "fairly empty," according to the listing. But the aircraft is sporting a full set of external stores, including 100 gallon drop tanks and SNEB rocket pods. "There is also a set of Aden cannon pods fitted to the belly."

#### Hangar Collapse Damages 7 Aircraft (With Photos)

click for more photosNo one was hurt, but one man had to be rescued and six airplanes and one helicopter were damaged when the roof of a hangar collapsed under the weight of heavy snow at Norwood Airport, near Boston, Wednesday. The hangar, occupied by Swift Aviation Services, reportedly had two people in it at the time of the collapse. Employee, Ted Robinson, who had to be rescued from a corner office told the Norwood Bulletin that the event was, "a little out of the ordinary." Fire officials were called to contain leaking fuel and a ruptured gas line estimated that damage to two of the aircraft was excessive. Images appear to show the tail of a Lancair IV P suffering under the weight of debris while the helicopter next to it is nearly unrecognizable. Meanwhile, a Piper Malibu (or variant) sits nearby relatively unscathed and a prop jutting from the snow behind it suggests another outcome for a different aircraft.
