EAA and AirVenture chairman Tom Poberezny confirmed today that the Boeing 787 Dreamliner is scheduled to make a landmark appearance at EAA AirVenture 2011 on Friday, July 29, giving aviation enthusiasts a glimpse into the next generation of commercial airliners.

Seven Survive Liberty Belle Crash Landing in Illinois

The B-17 Liberty Belle owned by the Liberty Foundation crashed in a field southeast of the Aurora, Illinois, Municipal Airport Monday morning at around 9:30 CDT, according to numerous media reports. All seven people on-board the non-revenue flight escaped the aircraft, but the airplane caught fire and was destroyed.

Terrafugia Adjusts Transition Delivery Schedule

Terrafugia Inc. has announced a delayed delivery date for its Transition roadable aircraft. Blaming third party suppliers and production design challenges, the company says it remains committed to the aircraft development program but that the first delivery would be in late 2012.
