#### Homeland Security, FAA Issue Aviation Advisories for 9/11 Anniversary

The FAA issued a special notice reminding pilots of numerous air space restrictions that will be in effect across the country on September 9-12, 2011, during 10-year anniversary observances of the 9/11 attacks. In addition the Department of Homeland Security and FBI has issued non-specific advisories regarding terrorism and GA for the same period.

#### French Man Makes First Untethered Electric Helo Flight

Experimenter Beats Sikorsky To Electric Helo Milestone A private experimenter working in France took on an assignment from a French company called Solution F to design, build and fly the world's first untethered electric helicopter, (pictured in Gizmag photo, above) and got the whole thing done in about 12 months. Pascal Chretien's first flight reached a height of about one meter during a flight lasting two minutes, ten seconds.

#### Boeing's Newest Freighter Ready To Fly

Boeing will deliver the first 747-8 Freighter to launch customer Cargolux on Sept. 19, the company said on Friday. Cargolux will fly the airplane away from Paine Field in Everett, Wash., that morning and put the airplane into revenue service. The second freighter out of the hangar also will go to Cargolux, with delivery set for Sept. 21. The carrier has a total of 13 of the new airplanes on order. The 747-8 is 250 feet, 2 inches long, which is 18 feet and 4 inches longer than the 747-400 freighter, with the capability to carry an additional 22 tons and adding more than 4,000 cubic feet of volume. Cargolux also took delivery of the first 747-400 freighter, in 1993.

#### China's First GA Fly-In Postponed

The first-ever general aviation fly-in in China, which was set for later this month, has been postponed indefinitely, according to AOPA. The event was scheduled for Sept. 22 to 24, with about 20 privately owned helicopters from around the country expected to gather at an airport outside Beijing. However, a helicopter operated by the Beijing Police Department crashed last month into a reservoir near the fly-in site, killing four of the five people on board. AOPA China said the crash drew "attention and safety concerns from the public and the authorities," and the ongoing investigation has raised questions about whether the airspace will continue to be accessible.
